Guidelines for Remote Proctored Online Descriptive mode and MCQ mode of examinations

The University has provided the online mode of descriptive and MCQ examinations to the students under CDOE (Centre for Distance and Online Education). It is the responsibility of these students to make all necessary arrangements of the minimum requirements to appear for the online examinations.

A) Basic Instructions for Online Examinations:

1. The students may please note that the Summer 2026 examinations will be held online from their own location through the **descriptive mode and MCQ mode** for the programmes comes under online education.
2. Additional time of 20 minutes only will be provided to upload answer scripts.
3. Check the internet speed before commencement of every examinations using speedtest.net and check the uploading and downloading data speed.

B) Minimum hardware and software requirement to attend the examination

The examinations can be attempted using either Web(desktop/laptop) or Smart phone (Mobile)

(I) Web (desktop/laptop):

- ✓ Processor- Minimum Core 2 Duo Processor
- ✓ Operation system- Windows 8/8.1/10/11 only
- ✓ Ram- 2Gb or higher
- ✓ Web Cam- Mandatory.
- ✓ Browser- Latest version of Google Chrome browser must be pre-installed in your respective devices. Student can download Chrome from here:- https://www.google.com/intl/en_in/chrome/
- ✓ Internet speed- Stable Internet connectivity with a minimum 1 Mbps speed. You can check your internet speed on this link - <https://www.speedtest.net/>.
- ✓ Google Chrome settings - Students need to allow permission to Chrome browser to use camera on the pop-up window.
- ✓ Image to PDF convertor (for converting the Written answer sheets to PDF)
- ✓ Uninterrupted power supply

Testing your webcam / front camera

(II) Smart Phone (Mobile):

- ✓ Smartphone with front camera (Android phones only, due to iPhone security restrictions, camera permissions may be blocked or limited, which can cause issues during the exam, so students should use Android devices instead of iPhones.)

- ✓ Ensure that smart phones are fully charged before the commencement of the particular examination.
- ✓ Go to Settings -> Go to Applications ->Google Chrome-> Permissions -> Allow permission for Camera.
- ✓ Student can install latest version of Chrome from Google Play store on Android phone.

C) Steps to follow on and before the examination

(Step: I) Preparation for writing the examination

The student should make arrangements for their own writing materials and stationery that includes:

1. Adequate numbers of ruled quality Journal Papers (A4 size only) (available in stationery shop). The answers must be written on only one side of the paper.
2. Adequate numbers of cover sheet (first page) of answer script. The cover sheet has to be printed or hand written as per the format given in Annexure I.
3. Adequate number of ball point/ gel pen (either black or blue color). For properly visible scan copy in PDF format use of dark ink/gel/ball point pen is highly recommended.

(Step: II) Before and During the examination

1. The student should login with the User id and password sent via email on registered email id. This User id and password shall be utilized for all the examinations.
2. The student should check the subject code and subject name in the Question Paper during the examination. If any deviation is found, in the Question Paper, they should intimate the same to the Exam coordinators of your learner support center/technical support team immediately.
3. The student should ensure that the place of examination is disturbance free.
4. There should be no other material with the student nor nearby while writing the examination, or else it will be treated as malpractice.
5. The answer scripts for every examination must have a cover sheet (as a first page and should be numbered as 1). The student has to fill in details as per the format and should not write any part of the answers on the cover sheet. The answers should be written from the second page onwards. The student should not write their seat number or PRN or any other personal identification details from second page onwards.
6. Since this is the online mode of descriptive hand written examinations, only a single pdf file of the answer script must be uploaded even if there are separate sections. For online education courses, MCQ questions will get saved automatically in the system and a single pdf file for descriptive questions should be uploaded.
7. Students should write the answers to the questions with **legible, readable, understandable handwriting (own handwriting) and should NOT type nor paste image of any part of the answer.** They cannot affix answer sheets written by other person. **If they do so, the answer scripts for the entire subject will not be assessed.**

8. The students using smart phone (mobile) for the examination should not receive/ dial a call during the examination. Turn off notifications in apps and browser popups to avoid distractions and exam terminations.
- Smartphone users can go to settings -> Applications -> Select the App-> Notifications -> Turn off all notifications.
 - You have to turn off notifications from all apps that could possibility distract you during exam- such as, WhatsApp, Facebook, Instagram, Telegram and all such other apps.
 - Please note that notifications and incoming calls would be considered as warning alerts and may cause termination of exam.
9. Extra time or extra attempt will not be provided if,
- (i) Student fails to appear for exam within specified timings.
 - (ii) Student appears for exam late / face lack of time.
 - (iii) Student ignores instructions and rules.
 - (iv) Student does not upload the answers scripts properly and not in time
 - (v) Student faces internet or power failure problems.
10. The student should keep the webcam/ camera on till the examination is completed. While writing the examination, the student should focus the webcam/camera in such a manner that their face will be viewable to the faculty member (as shown in the image).



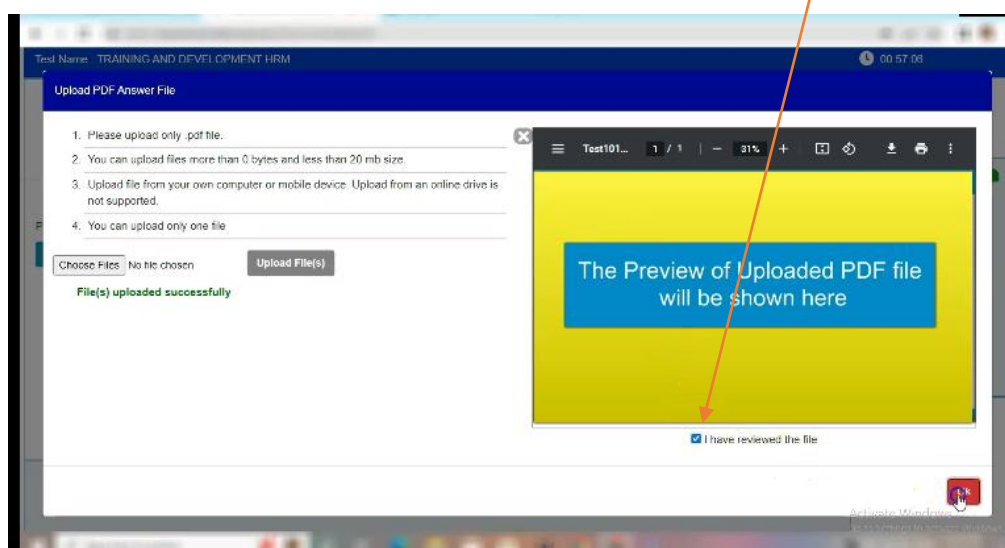
11. The student will be booked under malpractice without intimation if:
- (i) They turn off the webcam/camera,
 - (ii) They are not available in the webcam/camera for more than 5 seconds, (iii) They have any other material/objectionable material,
 - (iv) They are found discussing with anyone or using any other devices.
- In such cases, the student will be stopped/ will not be allowed to upload their answer scripts and no requests will be entertained.
12. Do not refresh the browser or switch the tab many times. Student may need to change the tab while uploading answer sheet. A siren will be played to alert the student about switching the tab. A maximum of 10 attempts will be given to students for switching the tab during online examination. If it exceeds above it, your exam will get terminated automatically.
13. Mock test will be conducted before university exam. You will be notified accordingly. This will help students to understand the question format and test the platform. Mock test is only for practice and not compulsory.

(Step: III) Scanning of Answer scripts - After completion of writing

1. After completion of writing, all answers scripts must be scanned/photographed (in portrait/vertical mode in readable format only and NOT in landscape or horizontal mode) either with scanner or smart phone. And make a single PDF file (of all the written answer pages including cover sheet) using any mobile app (e.g. camscanner, adobe scan, pdf scanner etc.,) or online.
2. The student should put page numbers at the right hand bottom on all pages of answer scripts and should arrange them in sequential order starting from 1, 2,3, etc.
3. The cover sheet shall only have details as per the format and should be numbered as 1. The student should sign the declaration with no. of pages written. The answers to the questions should be self-written from page number 2 onwards.
4. The student must ensure that the PDF file size is less than 20 MB. Files larger than 20 MB will be not accepted.
5. Please note that your session/examination will not terminate during pdf creation and pdf uploading process.

(Step:IV) Uploading of PDF

1. The single PDF file should be uploaded. No other file format is allowed.
2. After uploading answer scripts, they should check the uploaded file, number of pages in the file along with answer script cover sheet so as to ensure that all pages are uploaded. It is the **responsibility of student** to check the preview of uploaded answer script and tick the checkbox before submission. *(University will not be responsible for non-submission of answer script.)*



3. Once everything is correct the student should submit. After clicking on Submit Test button, the system will not allow any changes / edit to the uploaded file/document.
4. **The answer scripts will be checked for plagiarism. If the answer scripts are found to be plagiarized, it will not be evaluated and the case will be placed before the malpractice committee for disciplinary action.**
5. Answer scripts will not be accepted for evaluation, if:
 - I. The answer scripts are not uploaded within time.
 - II. The answer scripts are without duly filled-in cover sheet.
 - III. Details are missing in the cover sheet (e.g. PRN, Seat number, declaration and signature of the candidate).

- IV. There are blank documents.
- V. There are irrelevant documents (other than appropriate answer scripts).
- VI. The answer scripts are of a different subject.
- VII. The documents type is not in PDF format and more than 20 MB.
- VIII. The answer scripts are blurred/corrupted/ not in readable format and/ or page orders are jumbled/missing/the uploaded answer script are not vertical but rotated horizontally.
- IX. The answer scripts are typed and not handwritten.
- X. The answer script contains two different types of handwriting.

The marks for the concerned subject for which the answer scripts are not evaluated due to the reasons mentioned above under point 5. will be considered as zero marks.

Note: Answer scripts will not be collected in any other mode under any other circumstances. It shall be the sole responsibility of the student to ensure proper upload. If under any circumstance, the answer scripts are not uploaded/not available at the online system for evaluation, the University shall not be responsible and no such complaints will be entertained.
